- BIRD regularly conducts training programmes on Investment & Treasury Management for RRBs & RCBs
- Involves interactive trading games that simulate real-world financial markets allowing participants to engage in hands-on trading activities, making decisions on liquidity management, risk assessment, and investment strategies



Highlight of the month

BIRD, Lucknow & NABARD jointly organize first of its kind writeshop for project formulation under Climate Change Fund

- NABARD has created a dedicated Climate Change Fund - Interest Differential (CCF-ID) during 2023-24 under which projects demonstrating the highest potential for climate action are considered for funding
- BIRD in association with Dept. of Climate Action & Sustainability, NABARD & GIZ organized the 1st writeshop under the Fund in which 28 NABARD officers & 19 potential Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) participated
- The writeshop involved adoption of the Toolified approach for project concept note development through a mix of climate inputs supported by mentoring of participants for the concept note development
- At the end of the writeshop, the participants made a detailed presentation on the preliminary concepts developed by them for consideration under CCF-ID by NABARD



Environmental Stewardship: Advancing Green and Biodiversity Goals

- Situated on a sprawling 43-acre campus, BIRD is renowned for its captivating topographical features and green picturesque landscapes
- Using satellite imagery, Normalized Difference Vegetation Index (NDVI) of BIRD campus was calculated for last 5 years
- Yearly average NDVI of the BIRD campus ranges from 0.43 to 0.49 inferring that the vegetation in the BIRD campus is under Medium Vegetation Class and the plant health is considerably good
- BIRD continues to strive in its sustainability effort through rainwater harvesting, solar rooftops, waste composting measures, etc.
