- BIRD, Lucknow organized a workshop on “Adoption of Climate Resilient Agriculture & Livelihoods by Small Holder Farmers” on World Environment Day
- The workshop emphasized FPOs as vehicles for innovation and stressed the need for climate resilient technologies, crop diversification, and water management.
- Experts from institutions like CSIR-CIMAP, ICAR-NBFGR, Tata-Cornell Institute, and others shared insights on overcoming barriers and designing action plans for resilience
- Participants—primarily FPO farmer members—engaged actively, gaining practical strategies for sustainable agriculture in the face of climate change



Training Programme on Accessing Climate Finance and Voluntary Carbon Market for IFS Officers

- A five-day training programme titled “Accessing Climate Finance through National and Multinational Funding: Linking to Voluntary Carbon Market” was conducted from 02 to 06 June 2025 for Indian Forest Service (IFS) officers, approved by MoEFCC, Govt. of India
- The programme was **inaugurated by Dr. Nirupam Mehrotra, Director, BIRD, Lucknow**, who emphasized the importance of mobilizing climate finance and leveraging carbon markets to ensure last-mile impact
- **Senior IFS officers** from multiple states participated and engaged in sessions covering **carbon credit mechanisms, guidelines, and project design**, along with a **field visit** to a project successfully earning carbon credits for farmers
- Subject experts from **Government of Uttar Pradesh, BIRD faculty & GiZ** led the sessions, offering practical and policy-oriented insights
- The programme, conducted as a **blended learning model on the iGOT platform under Mission Karmayogi**, received highly positive feedback from participants and was **well appreciated by MoEFCC**, positioning **BIRD as a key capacity-building player** in this emerging domain

International Programme on Trainers Training Techniques
